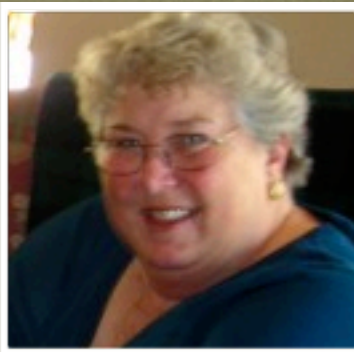
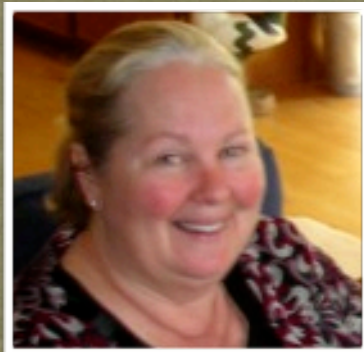


Ladies' Tea April 10, 2010

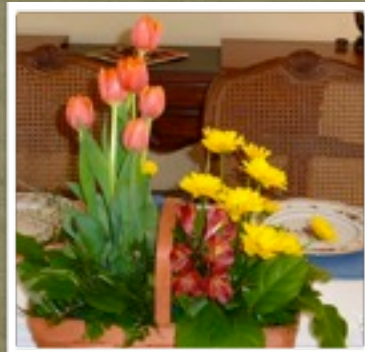
